At the outset, Dr. Pradeep Pagaria, Director Extension Education and Member Secretary, Extension Education Council welcomed Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and all other members. The Director Extension Education informed the house about the progress of the extension activities carried out in the University.

FEEDBACK SESSION (EXPERT'S FEEDBACK)

At the end of the presentation following remarks were given by the experts:



1. Dr. M.S. Chauhan, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, GBPUAT, Pantnagar

- It was suggested to adopt outcome basis work that can lead to increase the University revolving fund. For instance, to adopt "Local to Global System" for linking the local products with global market by more focusing on 'One KVK One Product'.
- He recommended adopting diversified agriculture system in the KVKs.
- It was suggested to emphasize on animal husbandry through popularizing and multiplying the 'Sirohi Goat' & 'Tharparkar Cow' breed, sheep & fish farming and organizing trainings by nominating experts of veterinary sciences.
- He advised to work on value addition and processing of agricultural products including spices, millets, milk and meat.
- It was suggested to work for popularizing the cultivation of cactus and rearing of honey bee in the remote areas of western Rajasthan.
- It was recommended to promote horticultural crop sand vegetables through protected cultivation.

2. Dr. Bijendra Singh, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, ANDUAT, Ayodhya

- Dr. Singh suggested that KVKs should carry out area based work, as KVKs are the 'Mirror of a District'.
- In the Western Rajasthan, it is essential to pay more attention on horticulture and animal husbandry (Goatry and Poultry).
- He advised to popularizing the cultivation of fruit crops viz. dragon fruit, datepalm, pomegranate and ber. A nursery should be established by each KVKs for dragon fruit.
- He also suggested to emphasize on water conservation and to conduct experiment by using drip/sprinkler irrigation system as well as to adopt and disseminate the mulching technology.
- He recommended for studying the "GAP analysis of productivity" through comparing the data of district, progressive farmer and KVKs productivity
- Dr. Singh also advised to make a document of case studies every year and each study should include at least 100 farmers of concerned component.
- KVKs should popularize the innovative technologies for the management of nematodes, especially in protected cultivation.
- KVKs scientists should conduct and strengthen the OFTs.
- It was suggested to link number of farmers by each KVKs with "Kisan Sarthi Portal".

3. Dr. Arun Kumar, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, AU, Jodhpur

- He appreciated the presentations and suggested that it may be further improved by incorporating related data.
- He suggested to conduct training in the adopted village.
- He recommended that each KVKs should effort to take at least one GI of a local product of the concerned area.
- He also recommended that each KVKs should make efforts to register the farmers varieties with PPVFRA.

FARMER'S FEEDBACK:

- Sh. Santosh Bishnoi, progressive farmer from Gudamalani said that agricultural graduates should apply his knowledge in the farming and try to establish as a model farmer for farming community.
- Sh. Ram Niwas Sahu, progressive farmer from Maulasar suggested that nursery and vermicompost unit may be a fruitful agri-business for the farmers.
- Sh. Pratap Singh, progressive farmer from Raipur advised that farmers should be



promoted for fish farming. He also suggested that MNREGA scheme should be link with the agriculture.

He also suggested to make more focus on cumin and isabgol research.

The meeting was ended with vote of thanks.
